Agenda-I

Deciding MCM for 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013 batch students.

- All the students get MCM (whoever applied as per criteria) for 2010, 12 and 11.
- Around 21 students from Y 13 batch could not get MCM. If the Director permits transfer of vacant seats from 2010, 12 and 11, 21 students might get MCM.
- An approval will be sought from the Director so that the vacant seats of all the above batches be transferred to Y 13 and Y 14 batch. Y14 batch has the highest applicant (406).

Agenda-II

Deciding MCM for Y14 batch (New students). Since Y 14 batch students don't have CPI, few criteria on top of Rs. 600000/- (upper cap of income) were set-

- Total scholarship available= 25% batch strength = $963\times0.25=241$.
- First 160 students will be chosen on the basis of top JEE rank.
- 30 Students from the pool of students with income level < 300000/-.
- 65% of the highest ranked M.Sc. (2 year) students will be considered for MCM after due checking of their income. Out of that top 65% rankers (for MSc), 25% will be considered for MCM.
- A total of 31 SC/ST students is available for MCM. If we don't find SC/ST students in the case when they go for FBM, rest seats will be again decided on the basis of JEE ranks.
