



The procedure for connecting to “Fortinet” noproxy

- 1) Connect your device with iitk network (select **iitk SSID** in case of Wi-Fi).
- 2) Configure your browser not to use any proxy server.
- 3) Access any http site from your browser (like <http://mit.edu>), you will get an Authentication Window as shown below:
