Item 1: Prof. Neeraj Misra informed the members that although the benefits of Family Pension, Death Gratuity and Retirement Gratuity are made available to Central Government Employees under NPS, the same has not been extended to employees of IITs under NPS. It was decided that the FO will draft a note raising these concerns which will be sent to Group of Directors of IITs for further consideration of IIT Council.

Item 2: Chairman, CCC, Dr. Mainak Chaudhuri presented the CCC report. After a detailed discussion the CCC Report was approved with one modification that one more tutor from MSE would be provided to PSO201 course for the 2017-18 – II semester.

Item 3: DoAA apprised the Committee that teaching loads of various departments are not truly reflected in the CCC Report as many departments use student tutors in various courses. It was resolved that this issue should be discussed in the next CCC meeting and a suitable mechanism for calculating teaching loads of various departments should be evolved.

Item 4: Prof. Indranil Manna (Director) presented a summary of the all 55 IAC meetings and agenda items held since November 2012. A number of new initiatives has been implemented during this time and most of them are working well. He thanked all concerned and highlighted the fact that consulting and collective decision helped.
