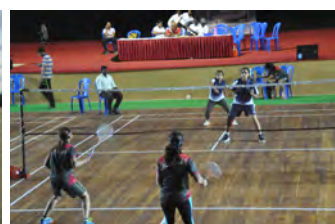


In Focus

Inter IIT Sports Meet

The Inter IIT Sports Meet is a much-awaited sporting event on the annual calendar of IITs. In the staff meet, IIT Kanpur has won the General Championship, held at IIT Madras from 25th to 30th December, 2017. This is the second time in a row that IIT Kanpur has been declared the overall winner of the staff championship. It secured the first position with a total score of 66 points, winning 4 gold medals in badminton (men), basketball (men), football (men) and lawn tennis (men); and 4 silver medals in athletics (men and women), badminton (women) and table tennis (women).

In the students' meet, held at IIT Madras from 15th to 23rd December, 2017, IITK secured gold medals in water polo (men) and weightlifting (men); and silver medals in athletics (men) and tennis (men). The women's team did well in the athletics events, securing a gold medal in discus throw and silver medals in the 800m, 1500m and shot put. In the final tally, IITK stood at the 3rd position with a score of 77 points.

Prof. Jayant Singh (Chemical Engineering) has been invited to join the editorial board of the new peer-reviewed, open-access global journal, *ACS Omega*.

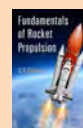

Their supply-chain ensures delivery within 12 hours, thus reducing vegetable wastage and also eliminating middlemen. The company has completed more than 7500 transactions so far and delivered over 1500 tonnes of vegetables to 70+ businesses in Ghaziabad, Noida and Greater Noida.

IIT Kanpur Signs MoU with Curtin University

IITK has recently signed an MoU with Curtin University, Australia for joint doctoral degree programs. According to the agreement, PhD students enrolled at one institution can apply for the JDP, after which the collaborating departments/schools from both the institutions would select potential candidates. The selected students will then be enrolled full-time at both the institutions. These students will have two supervisors from each university and also get stipend from their home institution. With this MoU, students from both IIT-K and Curtin University will get a chance to work with eminent researchers at both the universities and also to visit the partner institute for more learning opportunities.

CSAW was founded 14 years ago by the New York University Tandon School of Engineering. In 2016, NYU Tandon liaised with IITK and NYU Abu Dhabi Center for Cyber Security to widen CSAW beyond Brooklyn, New York.



The three-day event had a total of 14 teams with 64 participants from across India. The competitions included a hacking marathon, a hardware hacking challenge and a paper and poster presentation. IIT Roorkee, IIT Madras and IIT Kharagpur were the winners of the three competitions, respectively.

IIT Kanpur recently tied up with Ola, the taxi aggregator, to start Ola Pedal, a cycle pool service. Currently launched on a trial basis, Ola Pedal is aimed at solving the parking space crunch on campus, particularly in the Lecture Hall Complex and the Halls of Residence.



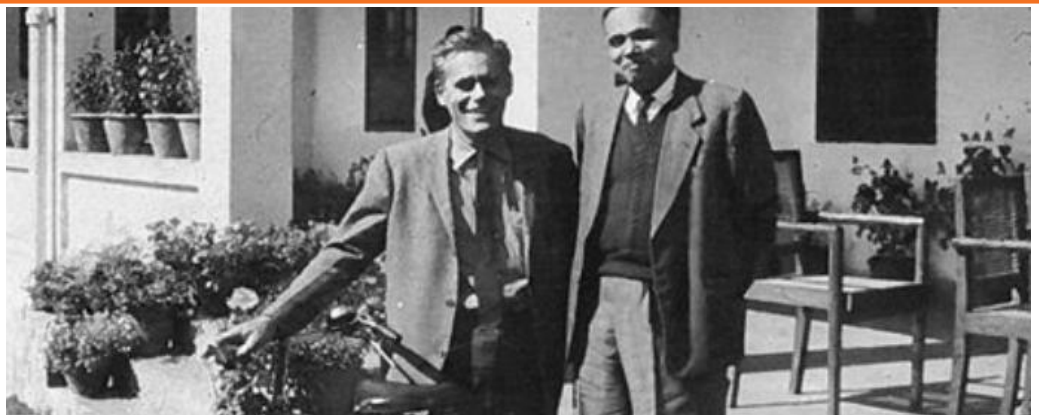
The Ola Zones have been clearly marked near all the halls and the academic buildings where the distinctively green-colored bikes will be parked. The service users simply need to identify a bike currently not in use and then enter the bike's number in the Ola app on their smartphones. The app will generate a code to unlock the bike. The bike can then be dropped off after use at the nearest Ola Zone. By notifying the same on the Ola app, the total fare will be generated. The usage of bikes is free for the first 30 minutes, after which Rs. 5 for every 30 minutes will be charged.
