1. The Bidder is required to submit quotation for both the Halls and will not have the option to choose any one of the two Halls.
2. IIT Kanpur reserves the right to cancel the Tender at any stage without assigning any reason.
3. The bidder should be a reputed vendor and must have the establishment of more than 5 years. A copy of the certificate of Establishment should be provided with the Technical Bid. The bidder must executed satisfactory work in any of the Incubator of Academic Institute of National Importance.
4. The bidder must enclose the documents of up-to date GST Return, with technical bid.

Technical Criteria

5. The bidder must have an average annual turnover of Rs 2 Crores during the last three years. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March 2023 of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid.
6. The Turnover Certificate along with the copies of Income Tax Return Acknowledgement, Balance Sheet & Profit and Loss A/c for last three financial years duly signed by Chartered Accountant of the bidder should be enclosed with the technical bid.
7. The bidder should have completed one single Order of Rs 55 Lacs over the last three years. (Purchase Order copy along with Invoice(s) with self-certification by the bidder that supplies against the invoices have been executed & Execution certificate by client with order value).
8. The bidder must executed satisfactory work in any of the Incubator of the Academic Institute of National Importance.
9. The bid submitted through email or any other online medium shall not be accepted. Only bid received through registered /speed post /courier/by hand shall be accepted.

10. **Sample Approval**

Bidders should have to display their samples of furniture (~~26/4/23~~) on date of opening of the technical bid at the Purchase Section of FIRST of IIT Kanpur. Non-Display of sample shall be considered as non-responsive technical bids.

Phase-II

- a. Financial bids of technically qualified and approve samples bidders shall be opened.
 - b. Financial evaluation is purely done on the total financial implication.
 - c. Any Superfluous, unreasonable assets rate quotes will be summarily rejected.
11. If the documents as well as the samples submitted by the bidder would not be up to the mark as per the tender requirement, the tender of such bidders would be rejected and the financial bid would not be opened.

13. The bidder must execute and complete all the work supply within 60 days otherwise LD @ 0.25% per day shall be levied. (Subject to maximum of 5% of PO)
14. Payment shall be as follows:

16. The bidder should furnish an affidavit on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of Rs. 100/- for not been black listed or debarred by any Government / Semi Government / PSU / Banks / Universities / Educational Institute etc. during last three years at the time of submission of tender bid for any item or by any reason. If any bidder, who has been blacklisted /debarred by any Government / Semi Government / PSU / Banks / Universities / Educational Institute etc. for any item or by any reason during last seven years, participate for this tender work, then the appropriate legal action shall be taken against that bidder and the client has full rights to black list / debarred the said company for future tendering process.
17. Bidder is desired to have executed one single Office Interior related work in a organisation of national importance of at least Rs. 85 Lacs value in past 3 years.(Purchase Order copy along with Invoice(s) with self-certification by the bidder that supplies against the invoices have been executed & Execution certificate by client with order value.)
18. **Earnest Money Deposit (EMD):** Rs. 1,50,000./-(One lakh and Fifty thousand only) must be submitted along with the technical bid. The EMD document (Demand Draft) should be issued in the favor of "IIT Kanpur "
19. MSME exemption allowed from EMD submission shall not be allowed. The Bidders MUST enclose the required EMD to participate for the tender.
20. The defect liability period of **Three years** from the date of completion of Work and final completion report duly acknowledged by IIT Kanpur.
21. The Bidder should quote for all items of the tender. Any tender for Part item will be rejected out rightly. An undertaking on the company letter head confirming the same should be enclosed with tender.
22. No Deviation in the technical specifications for any product shall be accepted at all. The bid must include every specification dimension and the details of manufacturer for each items. The images provided in the Tender document are for the reference purpose only.
23. No Subcontracting shall be allowed whatsoever.
24. Quotations from the bids that do not meet the technical criteria set in the tender document will not be considered irrespective of the price or any other criteria.
25. The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract.

26. The Vendor shall provide the warranty for 3 Years.
27. Rates Quoted should be inclusive of all taxes, freight and other charges.

29. An Engineer - In - Charge will be appointed by IIT Kanpur for supervision of work and verification of Bills.

30. Instruction to the bidder of countries which share land border with India (Rule 144(xi) GFRs)

- I. Any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT).
- II. "Bidder" (including the term 'tenderer', 'consultant' or 'service provider' in certain contexts) means any person or firm or company, including any member of a consortium or joint venture (that is an association of several persons, or firms or companies), every artificial juridical person not falling in any of the descriptions of bidders stated hereinbefore, including any agency branch or office controlled by such person, participating in a procurement process.
- III. "Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India" for the purpose of this Order means: -

- a. An entity incorporated, established, or registered in such a country; or
- b. A subsidiary of an entity incorporated, established, or registered in such a country; or
- c. An entity substantially controlled through entities incorporated, established, or registered in such a country; or
- d. An entity whose beneficial owner is situated in such a country; or
- e. An Indian (or other) agent of such an entity; or
- f. A natural person who is a citizen of such a country; or
- g. A consortium or joint venture where any member of the consortium or joint venture falls under any of the above

IV. The beneficial owner for the purpose of (iii) above will be as under:

1. In case of a company or Limited Liability Partnership, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has a controlling ownership interest or who exercises control through other means.

Explanation-

- a. "Controlling ownership interest" means ownership of or entitlement to more than twenty-five per cent. of shares or capital or profits of the company.
- b. "Control" shall include the right to appoint majority of the directors or to control the management or policy decisions including by virtue of their shareholding or management rights or shareholders agreements or voting agreements.
2. In case of a partnership firm, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s) who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of entitlement to more than fifteen percent of capital or profits of the partnership;
3. In case of an unincorporated association or body of individuals, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of or entitlement to more than fifteen percent of the property or capital or profits of such association or body of individuals;
4. Where no natural person is identified under (1) or (2) or (3) above, the beneficial owner is the relevant natural person who holds the position of senior managing official.
5. In case of a trust, the identification of beneficial owner(s) shall include identification of the author of the trust, the trustee, the beneficiaries with fifteen percent or more interest in the trust and any other natural person exercising ultimate effective control over the trust through a chain of control or ownership.

V. An Agent is a person employed to do any act for another, or to represent another in dealings with third person.

VI. In case of tenders for Works contracts, including Turnkey contracts, The successful bidder shall not be allowed to sub-contract works to any contractor from a country which shares a land border with India unless such contractor is registered with the Competent Authority.

31. As per the Ministry of Commerce and Industry Order No. P-45021/2/2017-PP(BE-II) dated 04.06.2020 preference shall be given to Make in India products for which it is mandatory for bidders to declare Country of Origin of goods and percentage of Local contents in the product.

Definitions:

"Local Content" means the amount of value added in India which shall, unless otherwise prescribed by the Nodal Ministry, be the total value of the item procured (excluding net domestic indirect taxes) minus the value of imported content in the item (including all customs duties) as a proportion of the total value, in percent.

"Class-I local supplier" means a supplier or service provider, whose goods, services or works offered for procurement, has local content to or more than 50%, as defined under this order.

"Class-II local supplier" means a supplier or service provider, whose goods, services or works offered for procurement, has local content more than 20% but less than 50%, as defined under this order.

"Margin of purchase preference" means the maximum extent to which the price quoted by a Class-I local supplier may be above the L1 for the purpose of purchase preference. (shall be 20%)

Purchase Preference:

- (a) Subject to the provisions of this Order and to any specific instructions issued by the Nodal Ministry or in pursuance of this Order, purchase preference shall be given to 'Class-I local supplier' in procurements undertaken by procuring entities in the manner specified here under.
- (b) In the procurements of goods or works, which are covered by para 3(b) above and which are divisible in nature, the 'Class-I local supplier' shall get purchase preference over 'Class-II local supplier' as well as 'Non-local supplier', as per following procedure:
 - i. Among all qualified bids, the lowest bid will be termed as L1. If L1 is 'Class-I local supplier', the contract for full quantity will be awarded to L1.
 - ii. If L1 bid is not a 'Class-I local supplier', 50% of the order quantity shall be awarded to L1. Thereafter, the lowest bidder among the 'Class-I local supplier' will be invited to match the L1 price for the remaining 50% quantity subject to the 'Class-I local supplier's' quoted price falling within the margin of purchase preference, and contract for that quantity shall be awarded to such 'Class-I local supplier' subject to matching the L1 price. In case such lowest eligible 'Class-I local supplier' fails to match the L1 price or accepts less than the offered quantity, the next higher 'Class-I local supplier' within the margin of purchase preference shall be invited to match the L1 price for remaining quantity and so on, and contract shall be awarded accordingly. In case some quantity is still left uncovered on 'Class-I local suppliers', then such balance quantity may also be ordered on the L1 bidder.
- (c) In the procurements of goods or works, which are covered by para 3(b) above and which are not divisible in nature, and in procurement of services where the bid is evaluated on price alone, the 'Class-I local supplier' shall get purchase preference over 'Class-II local supplier' as well as 'Non-local supplier', as per following procedure:
 - i. Among all qualified bids, the lowest bid will be termed as L1. If L1 is 'Class-I local supplier', the contract will be awarded to L1.
 - ii. If L1 is not 'Class-I local supplier', the lowest bidder among the 'Class-I local supplier', will be invited to match the L1 price subject to 'Class-I local supplier's' quoted price falling within the margin of purchase preference, and the contract shall be awarded to such 'Class-I local supplier' subject to matching the L1 price.
 - iii. In case such lowest eligible 'Class-I local supplier' fails to match the L1 price, the 'Class-I local supplier' with the next higher bid within the margin of purchase preference shall be invited to match the L1 price and so on and contract shall be awarded accordingly. In case none of the 'Class-I local supplier' within the margin of purchase preference matches the L1 price, the contract may be awarded to the L1 bidder.
- (d) "Class-II local supplier" will not get purchase preference in any procurement, undertaken by procuring entities

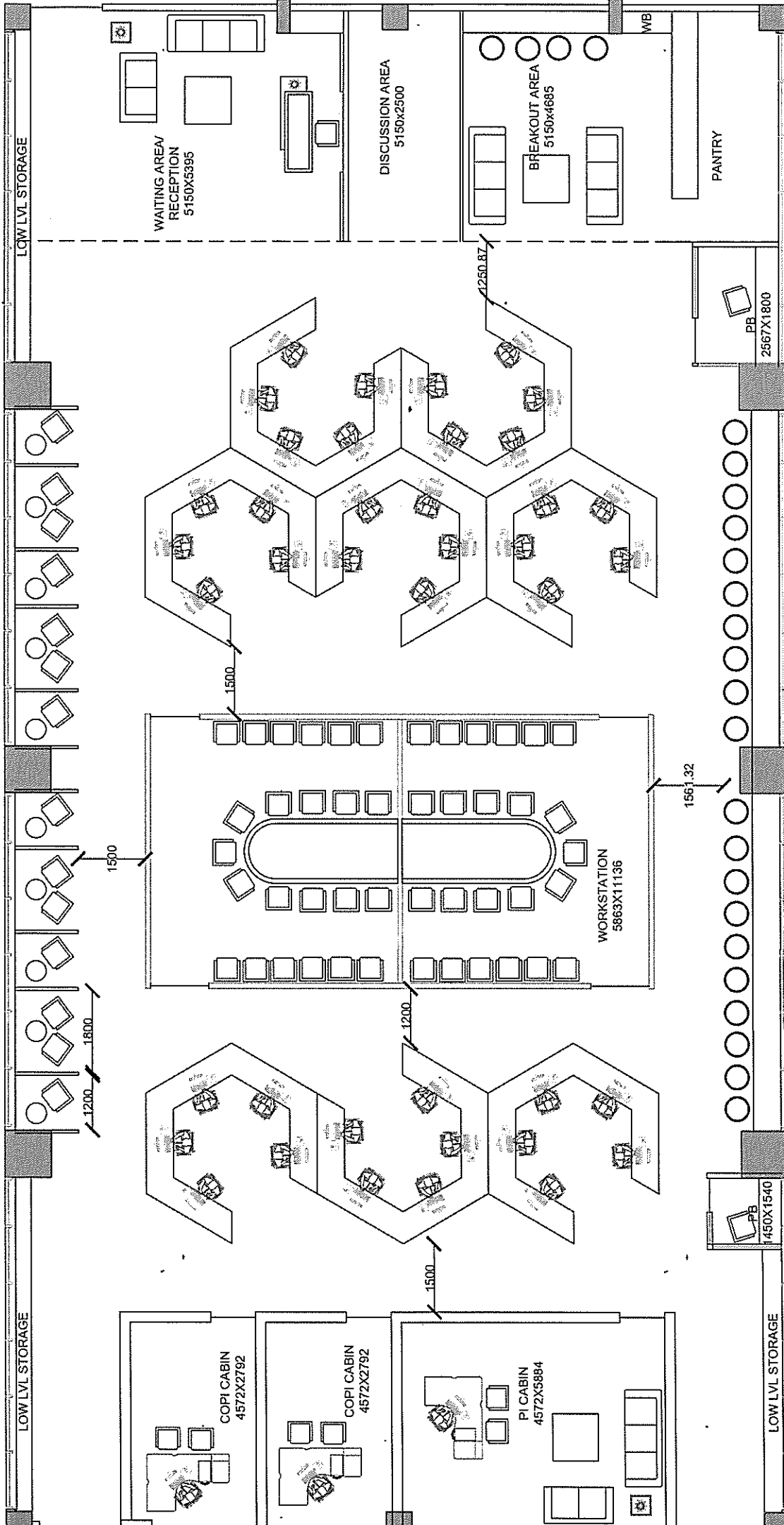

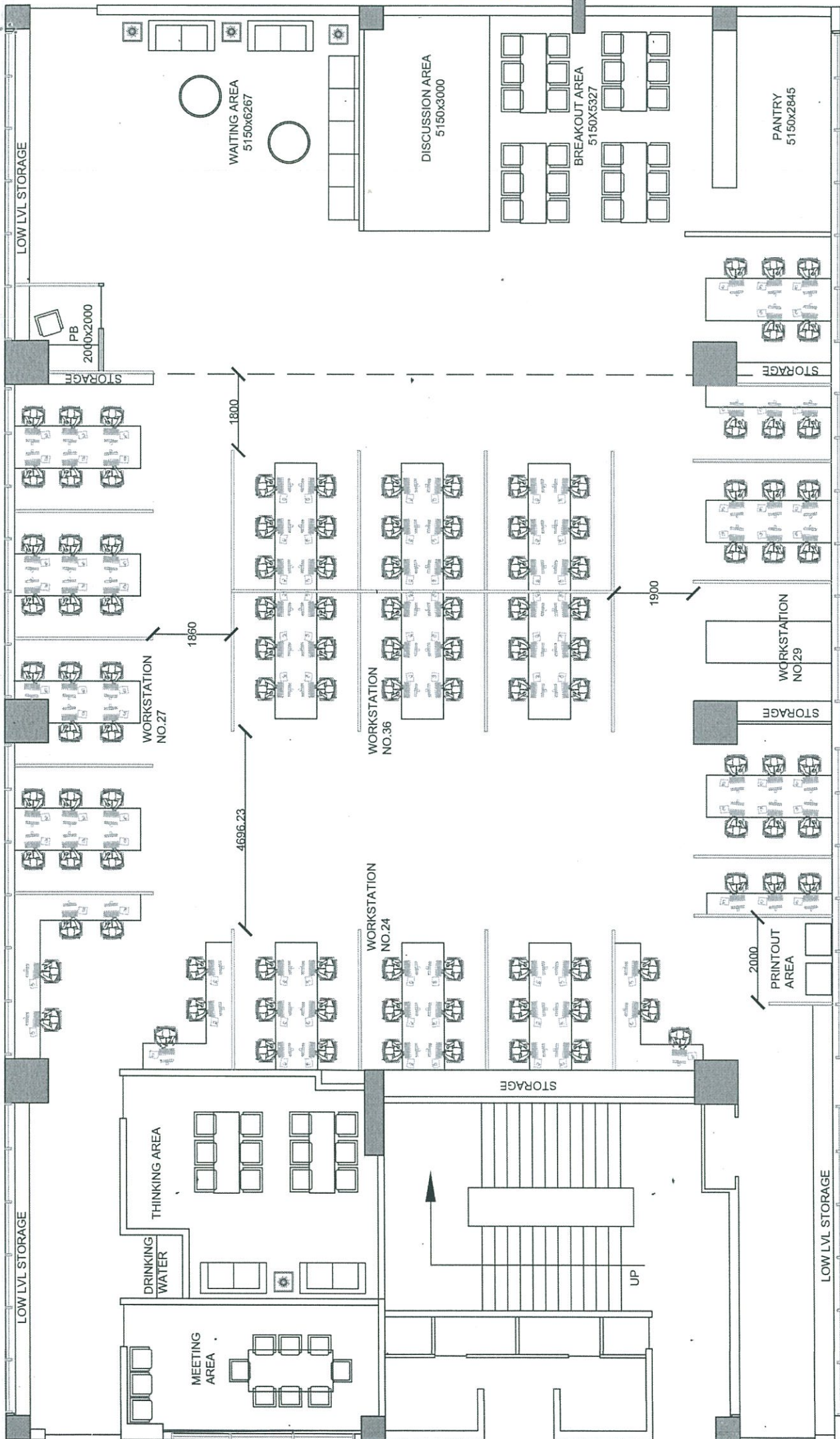
